■ Assignment - 15 points

Create a web page using HTML and CSS that fulfills all of the requirements listed below. Download text and images here:

Your HTML file should be saved as drakejmc.html and your CSS should be contained in a separate file named **mystyles.css** that is linked to the HTML page.

The assignment is due at the start of class on Feb. 28.

■ Requirements

For full credit, your page should include:

- HTML page and CSS page set up properly and linked together (2 points)
- Use all of the text and all three images on the page (2 points)
- Names of dean and associate dean should link to their bio pages on actual SJMC website (1 point)
- The width of the page overall should be 860px with an additional 20 pixels of padding on all four sides (1 point)
- The site should include two columns, with the content marked "rail info" in a narrower column (1 point)
- There should be a 2px solid black border between the two columns (1 point)
- The site should include styled top navigation as if there were these pages: HOME, ABOUT, CONTACT, BLOG (2 points)
- Your name should appear in both files (HTML and CSS), but commented out so it only appears in the code (2 points)
- All headlines and text are styled using CSS - headlines in Helvetica and text in Georgia (2 points)
- The page has a background color of Drake blue (Hex #004477) but the content background is white (1 point)
