■ Assignment - 15 points

Create a 3-page web site from scratch using only a text editor and an image editor. The point of this assignment is to show that you understand CSS, not necessarily to show how talented you are at designing web sites.

Your CSS should be contained in a separate file named **mystyles.css** that is linked to each of your pages.

Your site is due at the start of class on Feb. 16.

■ Requirements

For full credit, your site should include:

- Files named correctly and images in an "images" folder. (1 point)
- At least two headlines on each page (h1 and h2) - styled in CSS. (2 point)
- Paragraphs styled in CSS. (1 point)
- Two columns of text/info (on at least one page), created using CSS. (2 points)
- A "class" created using CSS and applied to a <p> tag. (1 point)
- A background image. (1 point)
- Content centered on the page using CSS. (1 point)
- All images sized to less than 200KB. (1 point)
- Use of padding and margins. (1 point)
- A list styled using CSS. (1 point)
- Top navigation on each page styled using CSS. (2 points)
- Links are styled using CSS. (1 point)
