■ Assignment (10 points)

Create a 2-page HTML site from scratch using only a text editor and an image editor. Your site is due at the start of class on Sept. 12. You likely will have time to work on your site in class on Sept. 7.

■ Requirements/grading

Your site should include (you will lose one point for each of these you do not include):

- A unique title on each page.
- At least one image on each page, with alt descriptions on all images.
- A background color on both pages other than white.
- Your site should have a set width (set up using a table, like we did in class).
- At least one H1 and one H2 on each page.
- You should set the font for your headlines using the font tag and not rely on the browser default font.
- Use of color (other than the background color) on at least one of the pages.
- A list on at least one of the pages.
- Actual text with actual information (not dummy/filler text).
- Each page should link to the other page.
- At least one link to an external web site.
- Home page named index.html.
